



Core Set Objectives and Measures - Stage 2 of Meaningful Use

(Must comply with all 17 core items)

- Use computerized provider order entry (CPOE) for medication, laboratory and radiology orders –
 - More than 60% of medication, 30% of laboratory, and 30% of radiology orders.
- 2. Generate and transmit permissible prescriptions electronically (eRX)

 More than 50% of all permissible prescriptions are compared to at least one formulary and transmitted electronically.
- 3. Record patient demographics (sex, race, ethnicity, date of birth, and preferred language) as structured data
 - More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP.
- 4. Record and Chart Changes in vital signs as structured data

 More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP have blood pressure (patients over the age of 3) and height and weight (all patients).

5. Record smoking status for patients 13 years old or older as structured data

More than 80% of all unique patients.

Use clinical decision support to improve performance on highpriority health conditions

Implement 5 clinical decision support interventions related to 4 or more clinical quality measures. (must have drug interactions enabled in system)

7. Provide patients the ability to view online, download and transmit their health information within 4 business days after information is available to EP

More than 50% of all unique patients.

- 8. Provide clinical summaries for patients for each office visit

 More than 50% within 1 business day.
- Protect electronic health information created or maintained by the Certified EHR Technology

Conduct or review security risk analysis and implement security updates as necessary.

10. Incorporate clinical lab-test results into Certified EHR Technology

More than 55%.

- 11. Generate lists of patients by specific conditions to use for quality improvement, reduction of disparities, research, or outreach Generate at least one report listing patients with a specific condition.
- 12. Use clinically relevant information to identify patients who should receive reminders for preventive/follow-up care

 More than 10% of patients with two or more office visits in the last 2 years.
- 13. Use certified EHR technology to identify patient specific education resources

More than 10% of all unique patients.

- 14. Perform medication reconciliation

 More than 50% of inbound transitions of care.
- 15. Provide summary of care record electronically for each transition of care or referral

More than 50% of transitioned or referred patients.

16. Submit electronic data to immunization registries from EHR Successful ongoing submissions. 17. Use secure electronic messaging to communicate with patients on relevant health information

More than 5% of unique patients.
